DEPUTIES WILL BE OUT FOR SAINT PATRICK'S DAY TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT

Additional Warren County Deputies will be on the roads beginning Friday March 15th through Monday evening March 18th. The Warren County Sheriff's Office received a Select Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant from the state of Ohio. Throughout the next year, the STEP grant funds will be spent on a number of holiday "blitz" efforts to reduce traffic fatalities. The Sheriff's Office will join in the effort with other agencies targeting specific areas of enforcement, primarily Speeding, Seat Belt Violators, and OVIs.

Sheriff Larry Sims urges drivers who are attending Saint Patrick's Day festivities to seek alternative transportation such as designated drivers or cabs rather than to drink and drive and remember:
