### **Warren County Sheriff's Office Investigating Burglary**

On July 2, 2013, an elderly woman was a victim of a Burglary, where the suspects posed as a contractor for the electric company. The woman, who lives on State Route 741, in Tuttlecreek Township, said a white male, average build and short dark hair, knocked on her door and represented himself as a contractor for the electric company. He was able to lure her outside, by telling her he needed to know where her property line started and ended.

Once the victim was outside, her home was burglarized. Although the victim did not see any other persons with the male, Detectives believe there were others involved.

The Warren County Sheriff's Office is continuing to investigate and wants the public to be aware of these types of scams to lure victims from their homes.
