Prisoner Fails to Return after Furlough

On Tuesday, October 29, 2013, a Dayton man failed to return to the Warren County Jail after a funeral furlough. Sherman Edmonds was granted the furlough by the Warren County Common Pleas Court to attend the funeral of a family member.

He was required to return to the jail at 4:30 pm. He failed to return. Investigators have checked his last known address but have not been able to locate him. Edmonds was being held on a felony theft charge. He now faces an additional felony charge of Escape.

Edmonds is described as follows:

Black Male, 53

5'11" 205

Black hair which is graying with a goatee
