### **Suspect arrested in Deerfield Township robbery**

On December 01, 2012 at 2:30 PM a female reported that while at the ATM machine at PNC Bank at 8600 Landen Dr. in Deerfield Township, a male subject threatened her with a hammer if she did not withdraw cash for him. The victim was not harmed.

The male subject fled the scene in a grey pickup truck after another customer pulled in the parking lot. The truck was located minutes later by deputies near the scene. The truck was unoccupied and still running. The truck was later discovered to be stolen out of the city of Dayton.

At this time a K-9 track was under way when a recently retired Warren County Deputy and now Warren County Coroner's Investigator Ron Robertson observed a suspicious male in the area of Kingsley Drive which is near the scene. Hearing sirens in the area he called the Communications Center and inquired if deputies were looking for someone. The communications center advised him of the incident. Robertson made contact with the suspect on the bike trail. He was able to keep the suspect there until deputies arrived and took him into custody.

The suspect was identified as William D. Jackson, 47, of Dayton, Ohio. Jackson had taken an unknown amount of pills prior to the incident and required hospitalization.

Jackson will be charged with Aggravated Robbery and Receiving Stolen Property.
