Ex-Police Officer Arrested in Deerfield Township for 1994 Kentucky Double Homicide

On November 15, 2013, the Kentucky State Police requested the Warren County Sheriff's Office attempt to locate forty-three year old Edward Carter. Carter was a former police officer in Kentucky, and was wanted in connection to a 1994 double homicide that occurred in southern Kentucky. Carter's last known address was in Mason.

Warren County Sheriff's Detectives were able to establish, with the use of the License Plate Reader system (LPR) that Carter was in the area in August of this year.

Warren County Sheriff's Office Deputies located Carter's SUV in a Deerfield Township hotel parking lot. Carter was taken into custody and is in the Warren County Jail, awaiting extradition to Kentucky.
