**UPDATE**

On November 29, 2016 at approximately 1800, Carlton Davon Meriwether II was found and is safe. He is in the process of being reunited with his family. Thank you to the public for your assistance.



The Warren County Sheriff's Office is requesting the assistance of the public in locating a critically missing adult. Carlton Davon Meriwether II, age 21, was last seen at approximately noon today in the Morrow area. He was seen pushing a bicycle with a flat tire, traveling towards Clinton County. He is believed to be wearing a green Hollister sweatshirt and sweatpants.

Mr. Meriwether resides with his family in South Lebanon. He is autistic and his family is concerned about his wellbeing. He is 5'10'' and weighs approximately 220 pounds.
